
Autism Solutions Academy Scholarship



The Carson Smith Scholarship is appropriated state funds that are used by the State Board of Education. The scholarship allows students with significant disabilities to receive funds to cover a portion of tuition for a private school that can better cater to the students special needs.



The Autism Solutions Academy Scholarship Fund helps to bridge the gap between the Carson Smith Scholarship and the balance of tuition costs. The tuition covers the cost of curricula, classroom teachers, classroom supplies, and community activities.



72% of our students are Carson Smith students.

28% of our students are currently in the process of receiving the Carson Smith grant.




